People wandering in from the streets	M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -If there are no more spaces left in the church, (because all of the spaces were pre-booked) then they will be asked to leave. If there are some extra spaces in the church they will have to sit socially distanced from other families. -If they do not comply by the rules, then they will be asked to leave. 	L	
Someone displays symptoms of Covid19 during the service	M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -We will have a thermometer to test whether they do have a fever or not. -If they do have a temperature, we will ask them to leave the service. -We will suggest that they go and get tested. If they do have coronavirus, we will need to let everyone else in the service know that someone does have Coronavirus. (track and trace) 	L	
Construction on church roof	M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -There are chairs placed around the construction zone in order to encourage children not to wander over there. -We will remind parents to keep their children away from that area.
